THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

II. V. Honour thy father and thy mother: that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.


VI. Thou shalt not kill.

7. What happened? Genesis 30:37-43.

8. Did this sit well with Laban and his sons? Genesis 31:1-2.

9. What did the Lord tell Jacob to do at that time? Genesis 31:3.

10. Jacob calls Rachel and Leah; what does he tell them? Genesis 31:4-9.

Lesson For Sabbath, April 29, 2023

8. Does he tell them what to say to Esau? Genesis 32:4-5.

NOTE: Remember the last time Jacob saw Esau, he had just stolen his blessing from their father.

Scripture Reading: Genesis 33. Golden Text: Proverbs 18:19.

2. What did he tell his servants to say? Genesis 32:16-18.

NOTE: Verse 20 says he is trying to appease His brother.

3. After he sent his family over the brook, what took place? Genesis 32:21-24.

4. Because he prevailed what do we learn? Genesis 32:25-28.

NOTE: Jacob has become Israel, the father of the Patriarchs.

5. How does Jacob present his family to Esau? Genesis 33:1-4.

6. When asked by Esau, who are those with thee, what does he answer? Genesis 33:5.

NOTE: The servants of God always give Him the credit. May we as well.

7. After their sister Dinah was defiled by Shechem what did Simeon and Levi do and how did they benefit? Genesis 34:20-29.

8. Does God confirm His covenant with Jacob? Genesis 35:9-12.

9. How is the death of Isaac recorded? Genesis 35:27-29.

10. Did Jacob and Esau stay together? Genesis 36:1, 6-8.

SHEEP AND LAMB REFERENCES

NOTE: The prayers of the saints are important to God. Remember, pray without ceasing.

8. What will happen to the world? I John 2:15-17.

9. How is this expressed in Revelation? Revelation 21:1; Isaiah 65:17.

10. Do we have any idea what God has prepared for us? I Corinthians 2:9; Isaiah 64:4.

Lesson For Sabbath, June 24, 2023

BEHOLD, I SEND YOU FORTH AS SHEEP

NOTE: The disciples were first instructed to go to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. Later, Peter was sent to the Gentiles or to other sheep.

9. What did Christ say to the Jews who doubted Him? John 10:22-26.

10. How do His sheep react and what is the benefit? John 10:27-29.
